She stated that three of them were actually usage time during the spring and summer season regarding softball and baseball. She reported that based on a request from the Mayor the only requests that were approved for usage were from March 2nd to May 15th due to the present Ordinance 2012-890 that we have will need to have some revision. She stated that she is in the process now of sending out the approval letters, packs of information outlining the general field use and a copy of the ordinance.

Mayor Green reported that the Borough applied for a Safe Street Sidewalk Program to finish off some sidewalks on 4th Avenue. Mayor Green stated that unfortunately we were not granted the request from the State.


