<u>ITEM</u>	<u>TYPES</u>	<u>HOW DO I DISPOSE OF IT?</u>	<u>PICK UP DAY</u>
Glass, cans, aluminum & plastics	bottles, jars, cans, all plastic containers with #1 or #2 on bottom	In yellow recycling container	Regular collection day
Paper Mixed	newspaper, magazines, office paper	Placed in brown paper bag or tied in bundles	Regular collection day
Vegetation	brush, grass, leaves, branches	Branches tied in 4 ft lengths Leaves, grass in loose bags	Regular collection day
Leaves	special pick up (curbside) April-May & Oct-Dec will notify	Loose bags during off season	Per posted schedule
Scrap Iron & Metals	all metal objects, stoves refrigerators, hot water heaters, heaters, washers, dryers, metal cabinets or shelves	Must call for pickup and be placed curbside	Every Monday
Motor Oil	used oil from cars, trucks, lawnmowers	Drop off at Public Works facility Mondays 7am-2pm	Drop off
Tires	cars & truck tires with or without rims	Drop off at Public works facility Mondays 7am-2pm	Drop off
Batteries	car & rechargeable batteries	Drop off at Public Works facility Mondays 7am-2pm	Drop off
Batteries	regular disposable household batteries	Regular trash	Regular collection day
Electronics	household items such as computers, copiers, TVs, vacuum cleaners, coffee machines, electric fans, etc	Place separate from regular trash.	1st & 3rd Mondays of the month
Household Hazardous materials	oil based paint, solvents, thinner, pesticides, gasoline, cleaning fluids, chemicals, fluorescent lite tubes	Call County Public Works for Special Collection Events 856-858-5241	Camden County Special Events
Latex Paint	open can, add kitty litter or sand and allow to dry out	Once can is dried out put in regular trash	Regular collection day
<b><u>MISC. ITEMS:</u></b>	Mattress, Sofas, Wooden cabinets Plywood & 2x4s	Regular trash Must be cut to 4 ft lengths, bundled/tied, free of nails, not weigh more than 50 lbs	Regular collection day Regular collection day
	Hypodermic needles	Put in <b>sealed</b> plastic container and mark "used syringes" and put in regular trash	Regular collection day
	Carpeting	Cut & tied in 4 ft bundles	Regular collection day
	Glass panels & Mirrors	Regular trash, must be covered with cardboard and taped.	Regular collection day
