Mayor Green opened the floor to the public.

Walt Davis – 1 Franklin Avenue

Mr. Davis asked in regards to Resolution 2016-58 and what was done at the Bowen Field.

Mayor Green reported that once the ordinance is passed the Borough will be putting in a walking path and that the cost will be \$28,000.00.

Mr. Davis stated that originally it was mentioned that the Borough would be putting cameras over there. He asked is that off the table.

Mayor Green commented that at the present time until the Borough finds more funding that is not being done.

Mr. Davis asked when the work would begin for the walking path.

Mayor Green stated most likely in the springtime.

Mr. Davis asked if the Borough has the money for it.

Mayor Green reported that the Borough has a grant for \$25,000.00 and the difference will be taken out of the recreation fund.

Mr. Davis asked about the 2% rider in regards to the budget year.

Mayor Green stated that there is a 2% cap on taxes.

Mr. Davis asked what the Borough does with the old police vehicles.

Mayor Green reported that the Borough will auction them off on Gov.Deals.

Mr. Davis asked about the school board receiving their funding and how the process works.

Mayor Green explained that they are quarterly payments. He stated that the Borough is the tax collector for the town and all the entities including the county; then once a quarter the Borough will distribute all of that money.

Mr. Davis asked who is responsible at the different entities once they receive the money if the Borough is not responsible.

Mayor Green asked at the individual organizations.

Mr. Davis stated for example the school board.

Mayor Green commented that those individual boards similar to the Borough board are responsible. He explained that the Borough processes a check and it then goes into the different organizations general account and after that it would be up to them. He stated that they get audited just like the Borough.


