**OPEN for BUSINESS: Mayor Green Implements New Evening Hours in
Pine Hill Borough Hall**

When Mayor Chris Green took office in January, one of his first initiatives was to increase the level of service to both the residents and businesses in the Pine Hill community. The Mayor announced today, that starting April 4th, the Borough of Pine Hill will be open for business on Wednesday evenings from 7 pm to 9 pm. “ I hope that everyone takes advantage of these services in effort to prevent our residents from taking time off from work to handle a matter at Borough Hall”, said Mayor Green. The Borough will continue with its normal business hours which are Monday – Friday 8:30 to 4 pm. The new late hours will allow more access to Borough Hall for those who need service outside of normal business hours without any cost to the tax payers. Residents will now be able to license their dog, pay their taxes and even pick up their permit for a new fence at their convenience. Mayor Green stated, “I am excited to be able to offer expanded service to the residents without increasing cost.” The Mayor will also have open office hours for residents to meet with him in person to discuss any concern, idea or problem they are encountering. The Borough of Pine Hill welcomes all residents, businesses and customers to visit Borough Hall starting April 4th on Wednesday evenings.
