






How to Report a Streetlight Out:

To report a streetlight out in the neighborhood, please visit [Report Streetlight Outage \(streetlightoutages.com\)](https://streetlightoutages.com).

There, you are able to zoom in to any streetlight, which will be indicated by a light bulb icon , and report it directly to Atlantic City Electric, who are responsible for upkeep of our streetlights.

Here, you will also be able to access other information about the streetlights. Green light bulb icons  indicate that there are no known outages for this light. If it is out, no one has reported it yet. Red light bulb icons  indicate that someone has already reported a problem with that streetlight and that Atlantic City Electric is aware of the issue.

Clicking either of these icons gives you different options. The green icons allow you to report a problem. Red icons allow you to view information such as the "Pole Number", "Order Number", "Date Reported", and "Status of a Streetlight".
